This is for the information of all concerned that the Admission of candidates for the Academic Session 2022-2023 shall be made on the basis of the Composite Merit comprising 75% weightage for the Academic Score of the qualifying examination and 25% weightage for the score of the JUET-2022.

Online Applications are hereby invited for Admission to the following **Post Graduate Programmes** (falling under the ambit of JUET) offered by the University of Jammu (UoJ), Jammu, its Offsite Campuses and Affiliated Colleges for the Academic Session 2022-23:

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS/INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATES:

- Any candidate who has not appeared in JUET 2022 is not eligible for admission.**
- Filling up of the Online Admission Form is a pre-requisite for Admission. The Candidates are required to fill the same carefully as per the Statutes. The University will not be responsible for any mistake/ lapse on the part of the Candidate while filling up of the Online Admission Form.
- A Candidate who does not opt for the Self Financing Seat/s at the time of the filling up of the Online Admission Form along with the requisite fee will not be considered for Admission under the Self Financing Seat/s at later stage.**
- No 'UNDER PROCESS CERTIFICATE' will be entertained under any circumstances for Admission under any Category.**

 - All Mark Sheets of qualifying examination in **single pdf file only**.
 - Category Certificate/s (if applicable).
 - Achievement Categories Certificates (if applicable) in **single pdf file only**.
 - Domicile Certificate.
 - Self-Declaration** (Affidavit by Notary-Annexure "A").
- The candidate desirous to be considered under the **Self Financing Seat/s** has to pay an additional application fee of Rs.730/- (non-refundable) while filling up of online admission form. The online payment gateway charges would be extra and shall be borne by the applicant.



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- 6) If seeking Admission under Reserved/Achievement Categories, the applicant has to upload Self Attested copy of the Domicile Certificate along with Reserved/Achievement Category Certificate/s issued by the competent authority as per Annexures.
- 7) A Candidate, seeking admission under any Achievement Category (i.e. **Sports, Cultural & Literary Activities, NCC, NSS and Bharat Scouts and Guides**) is required to upload a SINGLE PDF file only, containing all the achievement category certificates for evaluation. Achievement Certificate/s not uploaded in the requisite (single pdf) file at the time of filling of online admission form will not be considered for evaluation at later stage.
- 8) A Candidate selected for Admission under any Reserved/ Achievement Category has to upload all the certificate online (while filling up of Admission Form) and keep ready with the Original and Self Attested Copies of the Domicile Certificate as well as the other relevant Reserved Category Certificate/s as required and as issued by the Competent Authority. **Such a Candidate is required to submit these certificates to the concerned Department/ Nodal Department at the time of admission.** The admission of such candidate is subject to verification of the certificates by the Members of the Admission Committee of the concerned Department/ Nodal Department.
- 9) All the applicants applying for admission are required to submit an undertaking in the form of an affidavit as per **Annexure 'A'** (Refer JUET Website for details).
- 10) In respect of the Admissions to the Campuses/Affiliated Colleges, the Nodal Department/s will charge the University Fee and the other fee, as the case may be, shall be charged directly by the respective Campus/ Institute / College.
- 11) The Admission of a Candidate supplying incorrect/factually wrong information in the Online Admission Form will not be considered and is liable to be cancelled at any stage.
- 12) **Candidates are advised to be in continuous touch with the University/JUET website for admission notifications, eligibility and other details.**

Open Merit Seats:

Fifty-Seven percent (57%) of total number of seats available in a course of study as determined according to Statute 4, shall be filled up on the basis of open merit in accordance with the criteria given in Statute 13.

After selection of candidates is made on the basis of open merit, the remaining seats, notwithstanding anything contrary contained in any law, S.O, or regulation in force in the UT, seats under the reserved categories shall be filled as per Statutes and seats under Achievement Categories shall be filled up in accordance with the criteria given at Statute 12.

NOTES:

- (i) Admission to the various U.G. / P.G. Courses shall be made under Children of Defense Service Personnel / Para-military Forces and State Police Personnel as per the preference given as under :
 - 1) Children of Defense Personnel (Inter-Se-Priority among the gallantry shall be followed as Annexure V).
 - 2) Wards of Para-military forces.
 - 3) Wards of Police Personnel.
- (ii) All the benchmark disabilities as mentioned in the Gazette of India be considered for reservation for the Category "Candidates With Disabilities". A disability of 40% and more is eligible for admission under category (11). Certificate shall be considered only if it is issued by the Head of the Department of the concerned Medical Fraternity or that of a Government Medical College/District Hospital. The Vice-Chancellor, if he so desires, may seek advice in the matter, of a Committee to be appointed by him on the recommendations of the Dean Academic Affairs.
- (iii) Candidates with benchmark disabilities as defined in the Gazette of India shall be exempted from payment of all the fee including charges for supervision and amanuensis.
- (iv) For Single Girl Child, copy of the Ration Card and an affidavit duly sworn in before the First Class Magistrate on account of proof.



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- (v) Admission under Economically Weaker Section (EWSs) of society, are only for those who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservations for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribe, Socially and Economically Backward Classes etc. The reservation would be in addition to the existing reservation and subject to a maximum of 10% of the prescribed in-take capacity in each programme/ Course. These seats (EWSs) shall not be convertible i.e. if the seat/s under this category remains vacant in any programme, it shall not be converted to Open or any other category. The definition of economically weaker sections shall be such as may be notified by the Union Territory from time to time on the basis of family income and other indicators of economic disadvantage (**Refer Annexure-VII**).

Explanation:

- i) In case only one seat is available under category 9(a), 9(b) or category 10(a), 10(b) the same shall be filled on the basis of comparative merit of all the candidates under category 9(a) and 9(b), or category 10 (a) and 10 (b) put together, as the case may be.
- ii) For determining the number of seats under any reserved category mentioned at Statute 5, fraction of less than one-half shall be ignored and fraction of one half and more shall be treated as one. The benefit of fraction shall be given to each category separately even if it means an overall marginal increase in seats in any course of study.
- iii) In case any of the seats remain vacant in a reserved category (which are convertible) for want of eligible candidates, the same will be offered to the candidates of non-reserved i.e. open merit group.
 - Only such candidates shall be eligible for consideration under reserved categories in accordance to Statute 5 who have not already availed of this concession for admission to any programme of study in a Teaching Department of the University in any preceding session.
 - Selection of candidates against reserved seats Statute 5 shall be made on the basis of comparative merit in the respective categories, except achievement categories.
 - To be a beneficiary of reservation, the candidate must be a permanent resident/domicile of J&K UT, except when applying under categories 9(a), 9(b) i.e. Sports/Cultural & Literary activities and 10(a), 10(b) i.e. N.C.C./National Service Scheme/ Bharat Scouts & Guides activities, for which he/she must have passed the qualifying examination from the University of Jammu or from any recognized University within the Jammu Province.
 - For selection under achievement category, inter-se-merit shall be determined in accordance to statistic 13 B.
